**CERTIFICATIONS**

To simplify measurement for the North Americans, each competing boat must provide the following certifications **on or before September 1, 2004**. Please send your certifications to Jen Eielson, J/105 Registrar, Beverly Yacht Club, USPS Box 181, Marion, Massachusetts 02738.

1. Attached is a copy of Exhibit 7.3A - 7.3B to the J/105 Class Rules. This Exhibit covers floatline requirements, the procedure for equalizing weight (for pre-SCRIMP boats), and required safety equipment for racing. Exhibit 7.3B is to be certified by the Owner and your fleet measurer. Please note that your fleet measurer must certify items I and II. Also, if you race a pre-SCRIMP boat, your fleet measurer must certify that corrector weights are installed in accordance with item IV (*see* paragraph D5 in Exhibit 7.3A to the Class Rules). Your fleet measurer *may but is not required to* certify that your boat “floats to the floatlines”. The floatline measurement will be verified at the Regatta.

2. Attached also is a Sail Certification form. Please list the information for your racing sails, as indicated. This certification should be returned also to the Registrar by September 1, 2004.
