NOTICE of RACE

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing, the J/105 class rules and the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY: The regatta is open to all deep draft J/105 class boats that have properly registered with the organizing authority and are skippered by current J/105 class association members.

SCHEDULE of EVENTS: Harbor start will be announced on VHF channel 79 at 0900 hours and the first signal will be at 0950 hours.

SAILING AREA: Starting area in the vicinity of G3 east of Rose Island in Newport, RI. In the event of delay due to light air, Finishing area in the vicinity of R2 centerboard shoal at the entrance to Sippican Harbor in Marion, MA.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available at the fleet 14 web address and at the post-race registration desk at the Hospice regatta.

PENALTIES: The 720-degree penalty, Rule 44.2, will apply.

PROTESTS: Protests must be filed at the BYC and will be heard within the following week by the jury for the NAC.
