Storm Trysail Club's highest priority is to introduce junior sailors to big boat sailing in a fun and safe manner. In 1997 Storm Trysail hosted its first Junior Safety at Sea Seminar at Larchmont Yacht Club. This event resulted in one documented life saving of a junior girl who fell overboard during a race on Long Island Sound. The eighth seminar in 2004 attracted over 200 junior sailors who practiced in 21 borrowed yachts ranging from 34 to 45 feet. The Chesapeake Station of Storm Trysail has also been hosting Junior Safety at Sea Seminars. In 2006, three new seminars will be added to the schedule in Newport Beach, California (headed up by Ian Vickers), Detroit (Al deClerq), and Newport R.I. (STC Newport Station). Storm Trysail is pleased that the Jamie Boeckel Foundation is one of our supporters.

Storm Trysail's strategy is to continue to attract the juniors as they progress through college. In 2004, our Intercollegiate Big Boat Regatta held at Larchmont Yacht Club attracted 28 college teams racing J120's, J109's, Express 37's, J35's and J105's in three classes. Winners included Navy, Georgetown, and Kings Point. In 2005 the Regatta may expand to 35 or more teams.

The third leg on Storm Trysail's strategy is to provide great sailboat racing and post-race socializing for all sailors. Jointly with the New York Yacht Club, RORC, St. Francis and many other yacht clubs, Storm Trysail helped found the US-IRC office to promote the IRC handicapping rule. There is now a wave of enthusiasm spreading across America that is helping to re-vitalize big boat racing.
